- Course: Laws of arrest, search, and seizure; communications; arrest and control techniques; and firearms. Meets the Peace Officer Standards and Training (P.O.S.T.) and Standards and Training for Corrections (S.T.C.) requirements. Recommended for employment as correctional officers, security officers, or animal control officers.
Immediately follows AJ70R Correctional Officer Core Course which is 9/23/08-10/22/08

Depending on size of enrollment and availability of ranges, this course could be split into two groups. All enrolled students will attend the **10/30/08** range lecture date and meet at the Marysville Campus, unless notified otherwise. Agency sponsored students will have preference for the first range dates due to scheduling issues with their respective agencies.
- Fingerprints: **\$76.00** (\$12-25 **Live scan** fee for agency (cost varies); \$51 payable to D.O.J.)
Must obtain a live scan form from A.J. or use sample information on website to complete the document available at a law enforcement agency or provide agency clearance letter (13511.5 PC clearance).
- Medical Clearance: Each student must submit a **PAR Q, Health History Statement and a Medical Clearance** prior to participating in the physical training within this course (AJ54RA/B). An agency may submit a letter stating clearance through the background process; however the **student must still submit** the PAR Q/Health History Statement. Any concerns will involve further contact with the student and/or agency.

- Fees: Variable Units (.5 – 2.0): enroll with one or both of the following choices:
AJ54RA - 1.5 Units @ \$20/unit - \$30.00 (40 hr. course is arrest and control only) or
AJ54RB - .5 Units @ \$20/Unit - \$10.00 (24 hr. course is firearms only)
Student Service Fee - \$6.00 (one time per semester)
Duplication Fee for the 40 Hr. course - \$20.00 – fee includes Volume I-IV PC832 Workbooks (NEW) and scantron-200AS for the state examination.
Duplication Fee for the 24 Hr. course – \$5.00 – fee includes Volume V workbook (if attending all 64 hours course then total of duplication charge is \$25.00)

Firearms:

Please contact the A.J. office immediately if you are taking the firearms portion of this course. NO one will be permitted on the range without fingerprint clearance from D.O.J. or clearance letter from employer. Must show clearance in accordance with California Penal Code Section 13511.5. It is recommended that each student bring his or her own firearm, holster, equipment and gun cleaning kit (limited weapons available). Protective vests, eyes and ears are available for each student but we recommend that you purchase your own safety glasses for proper fit and clarity. More details will be available during the first course meeting. Range is scheduled for last three days of course and could be split into two sessions depending on class size.

REVOLVERS ARE NO LONGER ACCEPTED. Semi-Auto Pistols must be of a reputable manufacturer and must be a double/single action; 9mm or larger. Two magazines minimum will be required. *Civilian attire will be worn during this course*****
