

## **832pc Peace Officer Orientation**

**Course:** Laws of arrest, search, and seizure; communications; arrest and control techniques; and firearms. Meets the Peace Officer Standards and Training and Standards and Training for Corrections requirements. Recommended for Correctional Officer Academy, Animal Control Officers and Security Officers.

\* The Correctional Officer Core Course (AJ 70RA/AJ 70RB) immediately precedes these courses. The C.O.C.C. dates are 9/2/08 – 10/1/08 (177.5 hrs).

**Dates:** AJ54RA, Laws of Arrest (40 Hrs) -- 10/6/08--10/10/08  
Monday – Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

AJ54RB, Firearms (24 Hrs) – 10/13/08--10/15/08  
Monday – Wednesday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Depending on enrollment and availability of ranges, this course could be split into two groups. All enrolled students will attend the 10/13/08 range lecture but if the course is split into two groups, additional dates will be scheduled for the remaining 16 hours for group #2. These dates will be provided as soon as possible but cannot be confirmed at this time. Please check status by calling or periodically checking any revisions to this flyer. Agency sponsored students will have preference for range dates due to scheduling issues with their respective agencies. Again, we will attempt to give notification of the second set of range dates as soon as we have clarification of availability.

**Course Fee:** Variable Units (.5-2.0 x \$20/unit) enroll with one of the following choices:  
\* 2.0 units for all 64 hours (includes firearms)  
\* 1.5 units for 40 hours (excludes firearms)  
\* .5 units for 24 hours of range only  
A one-time student service fee of \$6.00 will need to be included in the above cost.

**Parking:** Day passes (\$1/day) can be purchased from the cashier or from the campus police department. Or, a semester pass can also be purchased for \$40.

#### **AJ54RB:**

**Fingerprints:** \$63.00 (\$12 Live scan fee for agency (cost varies); \$51 payable to DOJ)  
Must obtain a live scan form from AJ or use sample information on website to complete the document available at a law enforcement agency or provide agency clearance letter (13511.5 pc clearance).

**Ammunition:** 450 Rounds of Ammunition (vendor of your choice; costs vary)

**Firearms:**

Please contact the office immediately if you are taking the firearms portion of this course. No one will be permitted on the range without fingerprint clearance from D.O.J. or clearance letter from respective agency, which must show clearance in accordance with California Penal Code Section 13511.5. It is recommended that each student bring his or her own firearm, protective glasses, holster, equipment and gun cleaning kit (limited weapons available). Protective vests and ear coverings are available for each student. More details will be available during the first course meeting.

Revolvers are no longer accepted. Semi-Auto Pistols must be of a reputable manufacturer and must be a double/single action, 9mm or larger. Two magazines minimum will be required.
