

Academy Check List – BPA and Level III, II, I

Pre-Requisites & Miscellaneous Information:

<p>P.O.S.T. Entrance Exam: Please see academy flyer for listed dates.</p> <p>Basic Academy: There is no fee for this exam. Please bring photo I.D. and plan for 3 hours. Do not complete any other pre-requisites until you are confirmed that your T-score is within the top scores that will be selected to attend the current academy. If you have a T-Score already, please provide proof. You may test more than once and we will use the higher score. You will receive your T-Score results by mail within 7-10 business days.</p> <p>Level III: This exam is scheduled in the Level III Academy and is not a pre-requisite</p>	
<p>D.O.J. / Law Enforcement Agency Clearance: (\$12-25 Live Scan fee for the processing agency (costs vary), \$51 payable to D.O.J.) Must obtain a form from AJ “forms” location or a hard copy from office. Students affiliated with an agency may submit a letter stating D.O.J. clearance through background process (13511.5 pc.). Clearance must be 6 months current or continuing through the Levels at Yuba College.</p>	
<p>Medical Clearance: Complete the Health History/Par Q prior to taking the medical clearance document to physician for signature. (All Module cadets are required to get a medical clearance even if the cadet is sponsored.)</p> <p>Basic Academy: If you are affiliated with an agency, you may submit a letter stating clearance through background process BUT you must still complete and submit the Health History/Par Q.</p> <p>Level III, II, I: All students in the Levels are required to seek a medical clearance from a doctor whether affiliated or not.</p>	
<p>Background Application Packet: This packet is similar to the application packet you will fill out when applying with an agency. The Academy uses this as training only. Backgrounds are not performed. Affiliated students are not required to submit this document.</p>	
<p>DMV Printout / Valid License: Must have a valid license in order to complete the required E.V.O.C. (emergency vehicle operations course) hours or any driving training within an academy course. Each student for Basic, Levels III, II and I must also purchase a California Vehicle Code or Quick Reference from DMV (Current year’s edition – approx. \$12.00)</p>	
<p>College Registration: May complete the on-line application (“apply now” at www.yccd.edu) to create or update student account. No one will be allowed to be added to roster unless fees are paid, pre-requisites are met or proof of agency affiliation where fees will be invoiced by AJ staff. Email Michelle (mallen@yccd.edu) or Corrine (cgil@yccd.edu) upon completion of all pre-requisites for assistance adding name to roster.
