BOARD OF GOVERNORS FEE WAIVER INSTRUCTIONS FOR 2007-2008

YOU MUST SUBMIT THE BOG FEE WAIVER APPLICATION TO THE FINANCIAL AID OFFICE FOR PROCESSING BEFORE YOU REGISTER FOR CLASSES.

Steps to apply for a Board of Governors Fee Waiver:

- Must be a California resident.
- Method A applicants must provide required documentation to determine eligibility.
- Method B applicants must provide accurate 2006 income information.
- Dependent students must provide parent(s) 2006 income information.
- If you establish eligibility through Method B, we reserve the right to request proof of the income that you reported on the application.
- Must complete the application in ink.
- If you do not qualify under Method A or B you may qualify under Method C. Apply for Method C by completing a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

METHOD A: Must provide one of the following documents:

METHOD B:

BOGW INCOME LEVELS

Each additional family member add \$5,100

- For DEPENDENT student, the parent(s) total 2006 income (taxed and untaxed) must be equal to or less than the above amounts.
- For INDEPENDENT students, the student and spouse's (if married) total 2006 income (taxed and untaxed) must be equal to or less than the above amounts.

METHOD C:

- Student must have filed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Must have a Student Aid Report (SAR) with a valid Expected Family Contribution (EFC) on file with the Financial Aid Office at Yuba College.
- Student must demonstrate they have a financial need. The EFC must not exceed the following:

Dependent = 9,440

Independent = 14,984

Note: Please advise the Financial Aid Office if you are requesting a refund of enrollment fees.
