

## **2005 ALUMNI OF THE YEAR AWARD KEN ANDERSON HONORED**

Mr. Ken Anderson of Yuba City was selected as the 15<sup>th</sup> Annual recipient of the Yuba College Alumni of the Year award during the college's graduation ceremonies on May 20<sup>th</sup>. Anderson was chosen for this award in honor of his achievements both in regional business and in the arena of civic and charitable leadership.

Mr. Anderson is a recognized community leader, having served as a member and president of Yuba City Rotary, and as a board member for Fremont-Rideout, the California Prune Festival, the Yuba-Sutter Chamber of Commerce, the Buttes Area Council Boy Scouts, and the Yuba-Sutter Builders and Developers Association.



Mr. Anderson graduated from Marysville High School in 1970 and from Yuba College in 1972 with an Associate's Degree in Social Science. He is a fifth generation Sutter County resident with family heritage going back to the mid 1880's. During his tenure at Yuba College he was the Business Manager for the Associated Students of Yuba College (ASYC), and for the Athletic Department. In 1972 he was selected as the Outstanding Student of Yuba College. He transferred from Yuba to CSU,

Sacramento where he received his Bachelor's Degree in Recreation Administration.

Ken has worked in numerous industries throughout Yuba-Sutter including Division Manager/Sales Manager for SBS Building and Home Center and Senior Vice President, Chief Banking Officer for Feather River State Bank. Currently, Mr. Anderson serves as a self-employed consultant for the Anderson Group, which specializes in leadership training, marketing research and analysis, and overall business development. He successfully co-chaired the 2004 campaign in support of Measure M for the development of South Sutter County.
