Support Opportunities

Clear Lake Campus has a great variety of giving opportunities through which you can support their programs, services and students. Scholarships and Awards

Liberal Arts Scholarship (Dr. Robert Kirk): This merit-based scholarship (3.5 cumulative GPA) has been established in the name of Dr. Robert Kirk, a retired Clear Lake Campus faculty member. This recognizes students who have completed 62 hours and are considering transfer to a baccalaureate-granting institution.

Business Student of the Year (Ed Miller Scholarship): This scholarship is given in memory of Clear Lake Campus faculty member Edgar Miller. This is a merit-based scholarship that recognizes achievement at the community college level by

providing tuition and book support during the first semester of an awardee's enrollment at a baccalaureate-granting institution.

Lake Campus Progress Fund: The Lake Campus Progress Fund allows the faculty and administration to utilize funds where they feel they are needed the most. The Lake Campus Progress Fund has, in the past, supported the ECE Scholarship, the Human Services Scholarship, the Yuba College (Clear Lake) Medal, the GED Book/Exam Fund, and the McQueen Scholarship.

Programs and Projects

Clear Lake Staff Recognition Dinner: Established in 2006, this special event gives the faculty, staff and administration an evening to appreciate one another's accomplishments throughout the year. In order to give these individuals the classy evening they deserve, support is needed to help fund the many aspects of setting up such an event.

Clear Lake Library Reserve Fund: Library Reserve Funds are especially important for providing classroom texts for students who simply cannot afford to purchase them at the campus bookstore. Professors and LRC staff attempt to place several copies of primary texts in the library for both convenience and cost savings to students.

Friends of Clear Lake Campus: Whereas the Lake Campus Progress Fund supports primarily scholarships, your gift to the Friends of Clear Lake Campus supports special projects, activities and events. The "Friends" fund, for example, could be used to support graduation or opening day festivities.

Clear Lake Administration Account: The Clear Lake Administration Account is invaluable in providing money for repairs, campus beautification, software and other items not always available through the operating budget.
