### *Scholarships*

**Wettstein Scholarship:** Intended for students enrolled in majors in anthropology, geology, geography or earth sciences. Student must be transferring to a baccalaureate degree program.

**Town & Country Scholarship:** This scholarship is for students who are from the Woodland-Esparto area and have already demonstrated success in their initial studies.

**Kenneth E. Edwards Memorial Scholarship:** This scholarship is presented each year to a student whose passions are toward intellectual curiosity as demonstrated by a desire to continue beyond the community college level in seeking an education.

**Beeghly-Merritt Rose Garden:** This fund is dedicated to the beautification of Woodland Community College through the growth of rose gardens at various locations throughout the campus.

## ***Programs and Projects***

---

**Beautification Fund:** Aside from the roses provided through the Beeghly-Merritt Fund, Woodland College seeks ongoing beautification through landscaping, outdoor seating, and the little touches that etch campus life into the memory of students for as long as they live.

**Campus Progress Fund:** This fund has been established to provide the institution's leadership with the opportunity to direct money to where it is needed the most; scholarships, student emergencies, professional development, or simply to assist an academic program with supplies.

**Agricultural Program:** This fund has been established specifically to support the Agriculture program at WCC. Ag is an expensive program and to give agricultural students the edge in their education, much outside support is needed.

**Library Fund:** The library is the heart of a good college or university. Books, periodicals and on-line resources are the way today's students learn the "research" skills that will help them in any job they attempt to pursue. With Woodland College's new library and growing student population, support for the library will be more necessary than ever.

**Emergency Relief Fund:** Students, like all of us, have an occasional crisis that denies them the resources to buy books, pay for transportation, or afford a winter heating bill. Tightly monitored by the area deans, Emergency Relief Funds have become a way to keep a student in school while they face problems that are beyond their control.
