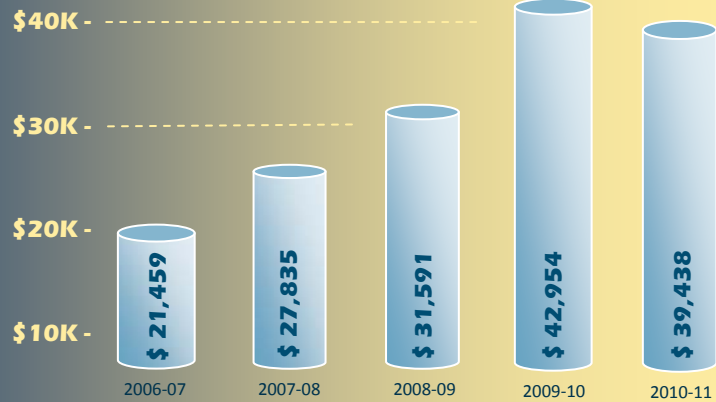

## Top 15 Giving Targets:

FY 2010-11

Giving to operations funds has increased considerably over the past decade. In the 1990s, better than 90% of the gifts to Yuba CCD Foundation were for scholarship support. In 2010-11, scholarships accounted for 50.6% of gifts, operations accounts for 20.6%, and athletic accounts for 29.33%.

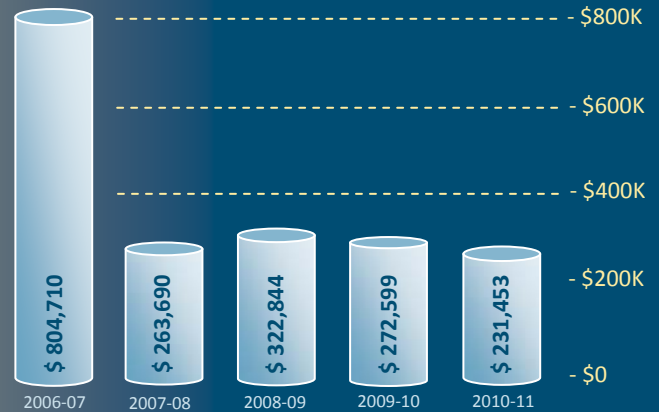

## Comprehensive Cash Gifts

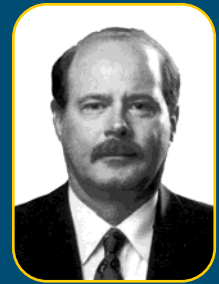
FY 2007 to FY 2011

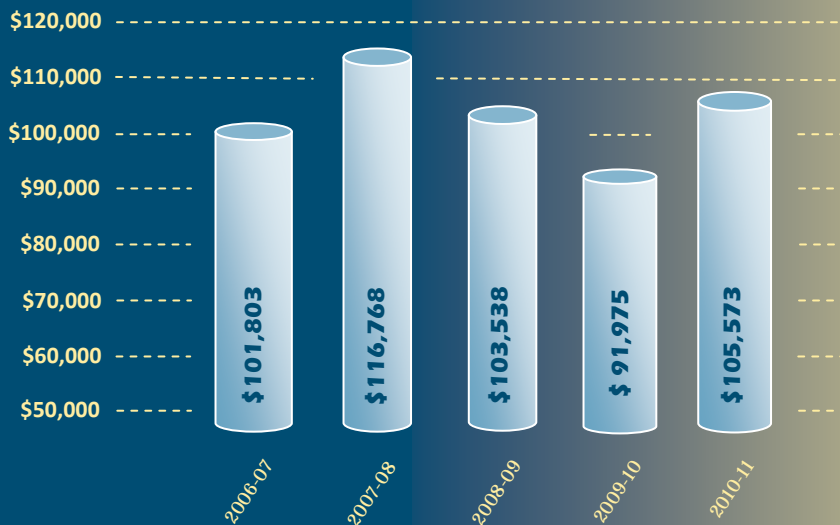

## Scholarship Giving Rebounds in 2010-11:



Scholarship giving has plateaued at a five-year average of \$103,931. This follows an era (2001-2006) when averages climbed from the mid-\$40,000 range to as high as \$119,004 by 2005-06.

These fluctuations, and the overall improvement that has resulted over the past decade, are due to changes in auditing and investing, each of which contributed to the growth and protection of the endowment corpus.

Scholarship giving should improve again over the next three years due to the influx of Osher Foundation funds. These alone will account for \$40,000 in annual student support.

## Scholarship Calculations

The above calculations are now based solely upon account transfers from the Foundation to Yuba Community College District. This (more accurate) method has revised downward the 2009-10 figure from \$114,846 to a level of \$91,975. Other figures were confirmed as consistent with previous statements.

Leticia Leyva was a 2011 winner of both the Osher and the DSP&S Scholarships at Woodland Community College. Leticia is a nursing major and is planning to continue until completion of her RN degree. She says that her WCC Scholarships helped alleviate a serious family financial situation.

## WCC Students Discuss Rigors Of Scholarship Pursuit

Attaining scholarship support is not easy. Each of the three students interviewed at Woodland Community College during Summer of 2011 indicated that s/he had spent between 20 and 30 hours preparing their scholarship application forms. They all agreed, however, that both their finances and their sense of self esteem benefitted greatly from this pursuit.

## Three-Year Campaign Successfully Completed

On June 30, 2011, Yuba CCD Foundation successfully completed its first campaign since the mid-1980s. The Osher Scholarship Campaign achieved and then surpassed its state-prescribed goal of \$344,760 with pledges and gifts totaling \$404,450. The only known previous campaign was conducted in the mid-1980s when the music department, spearheaded by Jaaquina Johnson, successfully completed Yuba College's Steinway Piano Campaign.

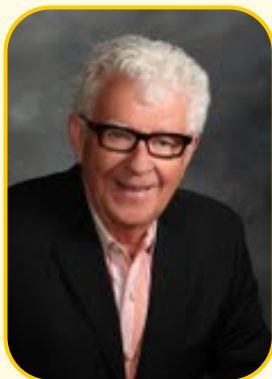

## Alumni of the Year Award - 2011



Joe Gannon  
Class of '54

Yuba College first began formally recognizing its "Alumni of the Year" in 1991. Since then, 21 alumni have been selected to receive this award. We are pleased to introduce this year's recipient, Mr. Joe Gannon, who traveled to Yuba College from Maui to receive this award at the May 2011 graduation ceremony.

Following a naval aviation tour during the Korean War, Mr. Gannon came to Yuba College in 1952 and earned his diploma in 1954. He is well remembered by his generation for having been one of several star athletes on the 1953 and 1954 football and baseball squads, both of which were contenders for conference and statewide laurels. His studies then took him to the prestigious Menlo School of Business, from which he earned his baccalaureate degree in 1956.

Dr. Gannon then embarked on a long and storied show business career which was kicked off by his 1956 founding of a contemporary folk group known as the Kingston Trio – a group that later topped that era's charts with several prominent albums between

1959 and 1961. Mr. Gannon has worked, as well, with at least 40 other internationally recognized entertainers and musical groups in the roles of Producer, Director, Road Manager and Lighting Designer. Even today many of our students and younger faculty are familiar with groups Mr. Gannon worked with including Neil Diamond, Paul McCartney, Alice Cooper, Barry Manilow, Frank Zappa and the 1980s super-group "Kiss".

Mr. Gannon has since joined his wife Beverly in forming three successful gourmet restaurants on Maui in the Hawaiian Islands. He describes Beverly, a gourmet chef, as leading the cooking and catering operations while he uses his business background to oversee other aspects of the operation.

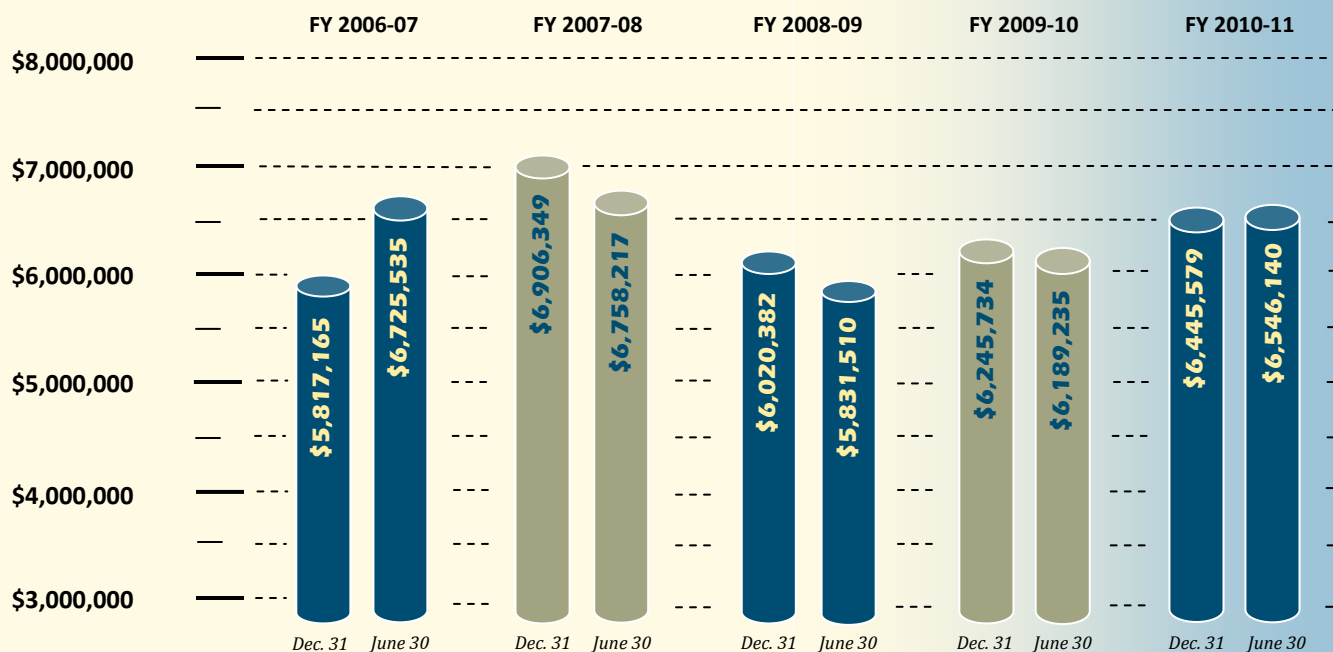
