Deborah Richter Memorial Scholarship – This scholarship memorializes a long-standing Yuba College faculty member who loved teaching. The scholarship recognizes both academic excellence (3.0 GPA) and community participation. The student should be intending to transfer to a four-year college/university to major in education and eventually teach.

Elmer and Clemmie Stohlman Memorial Scholarship – This scholarship supports students in the fields of education or radiological technology. It also recognizes those who failed to complete high school, but subsequently completed their GED and enrolled in college. Recipients are expected to maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0.

Judith Barr Memorial Scholarship – This scholarship was established to support students planning to be educators and who planned to matriculate to schools in the University of California system – or to Stanford.

Rose Huckins Memorial Scholarship – Established to support a student in the field of education or business. Community involvement is also a consideration. This is a merit-based scholarship recognizing students with GPAs of 3.0 or better.
