Deveraux, Georgette Memorial Scholarship – Georgette Deveraux, who was taken by cancer at an early age, grew to love the nursing profession and wanted to dedicate a scholarship to nursing students. Applicant should have completed one year of schooling, be enrolled in 12 semester hours, and have a 3.4 GPA.

Eileen Frye Memorial Scholarship – This need-based scholarship recognizes students going into the field of nursing. While there is no minimum GPA requirement, students must have achieved at a level that makes them eligible to transfer into a four-year program at a college or university.

Lois Miles Memorial Scholarship – Supports nursing students who are potentially interested in the areas of Gerontology/Geriatrics. This need-based scholarship is also reserved for students with a demonstrated track record of success in the nursing program and should also have been active, at some time, in community activities.

Tierra Buena Women's Club Scholarship – This nursing scholarship is awarded to a graduate of either Yuba City or Sutter High School. It recognizes academic achievement (3.0) in a full-time nursing student.

Tony Deegan Memorial Scholarship – This scholarship combines academic achievement and financial need in its criteria. Students must be in the LVN or AND program and must have maintained a 2.5 GPA.

William Wirth Nursing Scholarship – Offered to employees of The Fountains nursing facility in Yuba City. Applicant must be an LVN, AND or Psych Tech student and have maintained a 2.0 GPA.

Yolo Hospice Scholarship – This scholarship has been established by the Yolo County Hospice Program in support of its Latino Hospice program. Applicants should be in the field of nursing, fluent in Spanish, familiar with Hispanic culture, and capable of maintaining a 3.0 GPA
