# Science and Math Scholarships

(Engineering, Math, Physics, Biology, Chemistry)

**Don Hubbard Memorial Scholarship** – The Don Hubbard Memorial Scholarship supports a student from the sciences who is interested in issues relating to conservation and the environment. The student should have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 and be planning to transfer.

**Engineering, Math and Physics Award** – The EMP Award is donated to an outstanding student in engineering, math or physics each year. Donations have come from a large group of donors since the award's inception in 1987. This award has been managed by Professor Steve Klein.

**MESA Scholarship Fund** – The MESA Scholarship is given to a student majoring in math or science-based majors and who is a member of the MESA program. The MESA program has had incredible success in providing support to historically underserved populations who wish to go into these fields.

**Naso Scholarship** – The Vince and Debbie Naso Scholarship is a merit-based scholarship that recognizes those who have maintained a 3.0 (or better) GPA in math, engineering, physics or computer sciences.
