1.	<p>We learned at the 9/20 pre-submittal meeting that the District is planning to bundle smaller with larger projects to achieve some economies of scale. Given this, if a firm has submitted for the RFQ 08-001, which includes potentially many of the larger projects, does the firm have to submit for the On-Call RFQ in or to be considered for the larger project pool?</p>	<p>Please refer to the services requested and required by RFQ 08-001. The Architectural/Engineering services requested by that RFQ are distinctly different than the On-Call Services requested and required by RFQ 08-003J. To be considered by the District for the services described in each RFQ interested parties must submit a separate response to the District that conforms to the specific requirements of each RFQ.</p>
2.	<p>This inquiry regards the “STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION FORM”, page 4 of 5, sub-heading “LIST OF REFERENCES,” last paragraph, which reads: “I certify and declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the foregoing is true and correct. Executed this ___Day of___, 2003, at ___ [city and county], State of___.”</p> <p>If would be considered perjury, if we agree to execute this paragraph, due to the referenced year “2003” not “2007.”</p> <p>Unfortunately, we cannot alter the year on your preprinted electronic form; but we can strike-out the date, manually, or we can re-type the Execution clause; allowing the “Provider” to insert the correct year and insert the “[city and county]; due to not enough space provided on the referenced form.</p>	<p>Please strike out the “3” manually and insert “7.” Please have the signatory to the form initial next to this change.</p>
3.	<p>On page 4-7.2 of the RFQ, it does not list MEP as a discipline that is needed for services; however, on page 1-1.0 it says “engineering.” Does this only require civil & structural?</p>	<p>No. Section 7.2 of RFQ is herein revised to include the additional disciplines/professional services category of: Mechanical, Electrical, Plumbing (MEP).</p>

4.	In Sections 7.3B and 7.3C, are the project information to be listed under these two headings, supposed to be the 5 – 10 projects <i>which were subject to the jurisdiction of the Division of State Architect (“DSA”) or other State or public review agency having jurisdiction</i> as indicated in <i>7.3 Experience</i> or can they be other public agency public works projects/educational facility projects?	In information provided in response to Sections 7.3B and 7.3C may include and describe projects other than those listed in response to Section 7.3.
