### **VOCATIONAL NURSING PROGRAM ADMISSIONS**

 It is the STUDENT'S responsibility to meet ALL criteria to be eligible.

Applications may NOT be submitted until ALL prerequisites for the program have been completed. OFFICIAL high school and college transcripts **MUST** be submitted **WITH** the application. (Even if you have previously submitted transcripts to Yuba College, you MUST obtain a new OFFICIAL transcript to attach to your application.)

You should request **official** transcripts from your high school and other colleges attended to be sent directly to you. Do NOT open these transcripts when you receive them. Attach the transcripts (in their sealed envelopes) to the application. When you have ALL official transcripts to verify that you have completed the prerequisites, you should submit/mail the application and transcripts to the Yuba College – Math, Engineering, Science & Health Occupations Division. Applications submitted without OFFICIAL transcripts **attached** will be RETURNED to the student.

Yuba College offers a Vocational Nursing program designed to prepare students to take the National Council of Nursing Licensing Examination leading to licensure as a vocational nurse. This is a full-time program. Some classes will be taught at the Marysville campus and some at the Woodland campus. Applicants need to be aware that they will be required to travel during the program.

Enrollment each year is limited in the Vocational Nursing program. Yuba College has an established waiting list for qualified applicants for the program. New applicants who are qualified for admission will be mailed a contract by the Nursing Department. After the contract is returned to the Nursing Department, the applicant's name will be placed on the wait list – from which qualified applicants will be admitted to the class from their order on the wait list.

Applicants are responsible for meeting ALL requirements for placement on the wait list. To be eligible for the wait list, applicants MUST:

1. Complete the enclosed Yuba College Vocational Nursing application.
2. Obtain an OFFICIAL copy of your high school or GED transcript (do NOT open sealed envelope) and ATTACH it to the application.
3. Obtain an OFFICIAL transcript of COLLEGES attended (do NOT open sealed envelopes) and ATTACH it to the application.
4. Have successfully completed a high school course of study. Education equivalent to HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION may be established in conformance to the regulations established by the Board of Registered Nursing.

5. Have completed with a grade of “C” or higher, the following courses or their approved equivalents – (all courses must be completed and official transcripts (in a sealed envelope) attached to your application):
  - a) English 1A, Reading & Composition or English 51/51L Preparatory Composition & Reading
  - b) Elementary Algebra (or higher); two years in high school or one semester in college;
6. When an applicant is admitted from the wait list, the applicant will be required to provide the following to the Nursing department before the semester begins: (forms will be mailed by the Nursing department):
  - a. Physical exam (at the student’s expense);
  - b. A Personal Data Form and Health History;
  - c. CPR certification (Healthcare Provider from American Heart Association or Professional Rescuer from Red Cross)
7. Student must be able to meet physical requirements specified by clinical agencies with which the Nursing Department has contractual agreements for clinical learning experiences.

**All students will need to commute during the program and, therefore, need to carefully consider the human and financial costs of the travel. The District will NOT provide transportation to any site.**

**Applicants who have met the criteria will be placed on a wait list – from which applicants will be offered admission to the classes.** Applicants will be offered a space in the class based on his/her wait list order until the class has been filled. Qualified applicants will be offered admission up to the first day of class if space becomes available, based on their placement on the wait list.

## **APPROXIMATE PROGRAM COSTS – Vocational Nursing:**

FEES – per semester

Enrollment fee <i>(this fee is subject to change by the State Legislature)</i>	\$26.00 per unit
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Non-residents and foreign students are required by state law to pay non-resident tuition. The rate of tuition is \$159.00 per unit, in addition to the enrollment fee for non-residents from other states; \$165.00 per unit in addition to the enrollment fee for non-residents from other countries.

It is the applicant's responsibility to make sure OFFICIAL transcripts of high school and college work are ATTACHED to the application.*

**APPLICANTS SHOULD REVIEW ALL REQUIREMENTS TO MAKE SURE THAT ALL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA HAVE BEEN MET PRIOR TO SUBMITTING THE APPLICATION.**

**Individuals who have been convicted of felony crimes and some misdemeanors may be ineligible to take the state NCLEX exam which graduates must pass to obtain licensure as an LVN. It is strongly recommended that those with criminal records contact the Board of Vocational Nursing and Psychiatric Technicians before applying to the nursing program.**
