## Inviting All Licensed Contractors to Register on the Yuba Community College District (YCCD) Bidders List

Notice is hereby given that the Yuba Community College District (the "District") has elected to participate in the California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (CUPCCAA), "the Act." Public projects, as defined by the Act and in accordance with the limits listed in Section 22032 of the Public Contract Code, will be let to contract by informal procedures as set forth in Sections 22032-22045 of the Public Contract Code. All licensed contractors are invited to submit the name of their firm to the District for inclusion in the District's list of qualified bidders for Calendar Year 2008.

Interested Contractors are required to complete and submit to the District the "Yuba Community College District (YCCD) Bidders List Information Form". This can be found on the District webpage at <http://www.yccd.edu/purchasing/cupccaa.html>. Contractors are to download this form, provide all required and requested information, and submit the form to the Director of Purchasing/Contracts, 2088 North Beale Road, Marysville, California, 95901. All submittals, via email or facsimile, must be clearly labeled "**Yuba Community College District CUPCCAA, Bidders List Information Form Submittal**". Information required on the form will include, but not be limited to:

1. The name and complete address, including zip code, to which a Notice To Contractors or Proposal should be mailed.
2. The telephone and facsimile numbers and e-mail address at which the Contractor may be reached.
3. The Class of the Contractor's License(s) held and Contractor License Number(s).
4. The type(s) of work in which the Contractor is interested **and currently licensed** to perform, such as, but not limited to, General Engineering, General Building, or Specialty Contracting such as, Electrical, Mechanical, Plumbing, Structural, Heating, Ventilating, and Air-Conditioning (HVAC), Earthwork, Pipelines, Painting, Carpentry, Concrete, Demolition, Excavation, Landscaping, Masonry, Painting, Roofing, Etc.

This announcement is sent to various trades journal for publication as a requirement of the California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Procedures to establish and maintain a list qualified contractors per the applicable sections of the Public Contract Code.
