



Fall 2006 Demographics



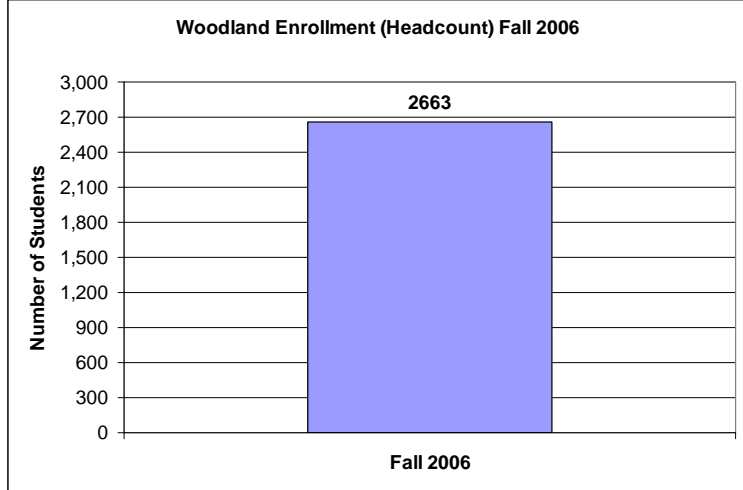

Due to the dynamic nature of any transactional data system the data are constantly being updated and this report represents a "picture in time" of that data.

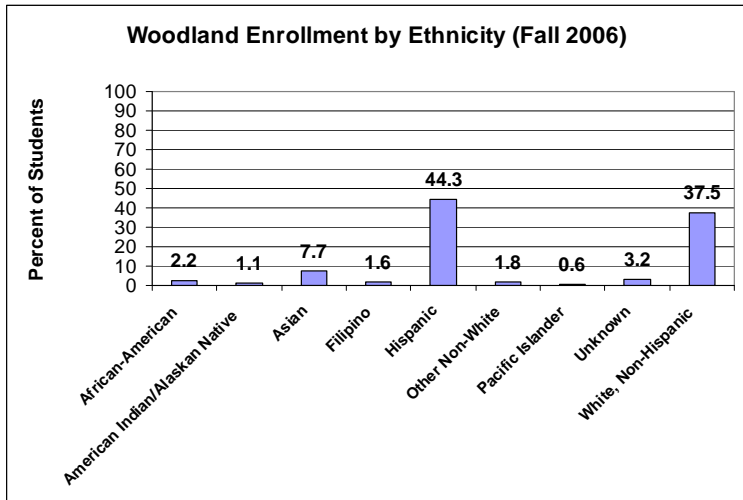

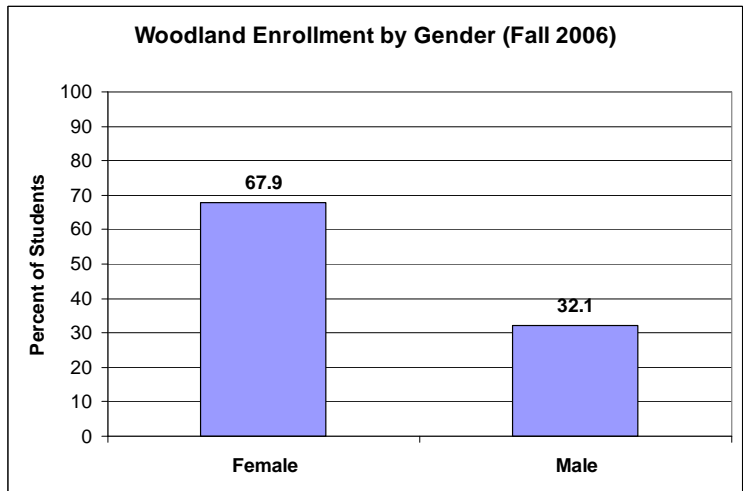

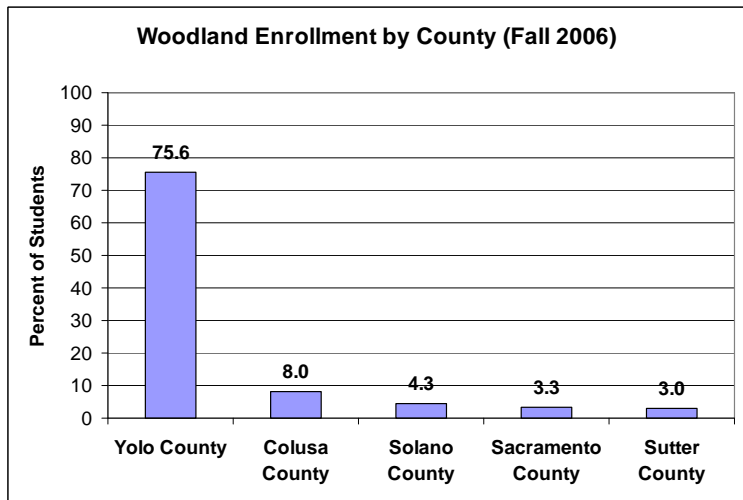
