
# YCCD Daily Update

Friday, April 10, 2020

Daily Update provides information on the current status of the COVID-19 crisis related to Yuba Community College District, and shares information from both local, state and national media outlets.

## **CURRENT STATUS**

As of this morning there were a total of 114 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in the service area of Yuba Community College District; three in Colusa County, three in Lake County, 22 in Sutter County, 71 in Yolo County (17 of which are in Woodland) and 15 in Yuba County. That is an increase of six from yesterday. In Yolo County 823 people have been tested and in Yuba-Sutter Counties 852 people have been tested. Testing numbers for Lake and Colusa are not available. Statewide there are a total of 18,309 confirmed cases reported as of April 8, 2020 according to the California Department of Public Health.
