
Wednesday, April 22, 2020

Daily Update provides information on the current status of the COVID-19 crisis related to Yuba Community College District, and shares information from both local, state and national media outlets.



CURRENT STATUS

As of this morning there were a total of 197 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in the service area of Yuba Community College District; three in Colusa County, six in Lake County, 26 in Sutter County, 146 in Yolo County (75 of which are in Woodland) and 16 in Yuba County. That is an increase of 4 from yesterday's update. In Yolo County 1,511 people have been tested, and in Yuba-Sutter Counties 1,349 people have been tested. Testing numbers for Colusa and Lake County are not available. Statewide there are a total of 33,261 confirmed cases reported on April 20, 2020 according to the California Department of Public Health.
