



Cyber Threats

We were already experiencing increased threats because of the COVID issue, so a few weeks ago the district implemented the Caution information for all external emails to help employees identify scams. For instance, this message from Kyra, which she sent from her personal email was flagged with the Caution symbol in the header, because it came from an outside email address.



In messages from outside email addresses, users will see the bright yellow bar with instructions to be careful in clicking links and opening attachments. We strongly encourage you to pay attention to this header and confirm the source of the message before opening any links or attachments.



We hope that by identifying these external emails, we are helping faculty and staff identify messages that may not be from legitimate sources and remind you to only open links or attachments if you know the sender and/or expected the email.
