## **YCCD Friday Update**

Friday, May 1, 2020

This Update provides information on COVID-19 related to Yuba Community College District, and shares information, resources and news from local, state and national media outlets. Updates will now be provided twice per week on Monday and Friday.

#### **CURRENT STATUS**

As of the end of the day on April 30 there were a total of 222 confirmed cases of coronavirus in the communities served by the Yuba Community College District. Since last Friday, there have been an average of approximately 1.7 new cases reported per day. Currently there are 2 patients hospitalized on the District.

A total of 4,229 tests have been conducted in the service area.

Statewide there are a total of 50,442 confirmed cases according to the <u>California Department of Public Health</u>.


