- 1. The District is requesting that qualified Architecture Engineering Firms (AE Firms) provide Pre-Qualification Packages in response to this RFQ. Please make sure that all required sub-consultant Fire Alarm System Design Firm information is also included in the RFQ Package. Describe the project team members and the work that they have done together on previous projects. Please describe how many years the A/E firm and the Fire Alarm Systems Design Firm have been working together on previous projects, roles, and time commitments of each project team member.
- 2. Please include all certifications, licenses of the firm. Include a list of Fire Alarm System Manufacturers that the Fire Alarm Systems Design firm is qualified to design. Include qualifications in designing **Notifier** and **Edwards** manufacturers Fire Alarm Systems.
- 3. Please describe the level/depth of field investigation and inspection of the existing conditions to gather information at the College on the various existing Fire Alarm Systems prior to commencing with the design work. The District has very limited drawings on the older fire alarm systems. Please plan to do substantial on campus investigations and inspections of the existing systems including establishment of underground conduit pathways between buildings.
- 4. Reference: page 3, Appendix D should read "Project Planning Documents".
- 5. Reference: page 9, Item F.3, should read "Describe in detail, the depth and extent of design experience in providing Fire Alarm Upgrade design and planning services for California Community Colleges, Universities or other large public institutions. Other multi-building fire alarm upgrade projects may also be included in this assessment.
