YCCD Monday Memo

Monday, July 13, 2020

This update provides information primarily on COVID-19 issues related to Yuba Community College District, and shares information, resources and news from local, state and national media outlets. During the summer updates are provided twice per week on Monday and Thursday.

CURRENT STATUS BY THE NUMBERS

As of Sunday, July 12, there were a total of 1,751 confirmed cases of coronavirus in the five counties served by the Yuba Community College District. That is a 44% increase over the previous week, and the fifth week in a row with a double digit increase. Current case totals are: Colusa – 113, a 61% increase; Lake – 108, a 24% increase; Sutter – 403, a 60% increase; Yolo – 929, a 37% increase with 473 cases in Woodland, a 49% increase; and Yuba – 198, a 55% increase. A total of 35,767 people have been tested, an increase of 43% over the previous week. Currently there are 40 patients hospitalized, 48% increase, in the service area of the District, and 36 fatalities, four more than last week.

Statewide there are a total of 320,804 confirmed cases, an increase of 23% over the previous week. A total of 5,406,599 tests have been completed, an increase of 16%. Total patients currently hospitalized are 6,322, a 38% increase and the number of ICU patients is 1,806, an increase of 30%.
