
YCCD Monday Memo

Monday, August 3, 2020

This update provides information primarily on COVID-19 issues related to Yuba Community College District, and shares information, resources and news from local, state and national media outlets. During the summer updates are provided twice per week on Monday and Thursday.

CURRENT STATUS BY THE NUMBERS

As of this morning, there are a total of 3,391 confirmed cases of coronavirus in the five counties served by the Yuba Community College District. That is a 19% increase over the previous week. This is the fourth week in a row where the percentage of increase has declined from the previous week.

Current case totals are: Colusa – 327, a 24% increase; Lake – 195, a 16% increase; Sutter – 795, a 23% increase; Yolo – 1,572, a 13% increase with 734 cases in Woodland, a 11% increase; and Yuba – 502, a 31% increase. All counties saw an increase at a rate less than the previous week. A total of 49,444 people have been tested, an increase of 9% over the previous week. Currently there are 32 patients hospitalized in our service area, a 20% decrease from the previous week, and 52 fatalities, five more than last week. Local data comes from county coronavirus web pages.

Statewide there are a total of 509,162 confirmed cases, an increase of 12% over the previous week. A total of 8,035,975 tests have been completed, an increase of 12%. Total patients currently hospitalized are 6,362, a 9% decrease and the number of ICU patients is 1,940, a decrease of 3%. Currently Colusa, Sutter, Yolo and Yuba County are on the states watch list. Yolo County has issued a mass isolation and quarantine <u>order</u> for all individuals with a positive COVID-19 and all individuals who have been in close contact with a positive COVID-19 individual to comply with quarantine health requirements.
