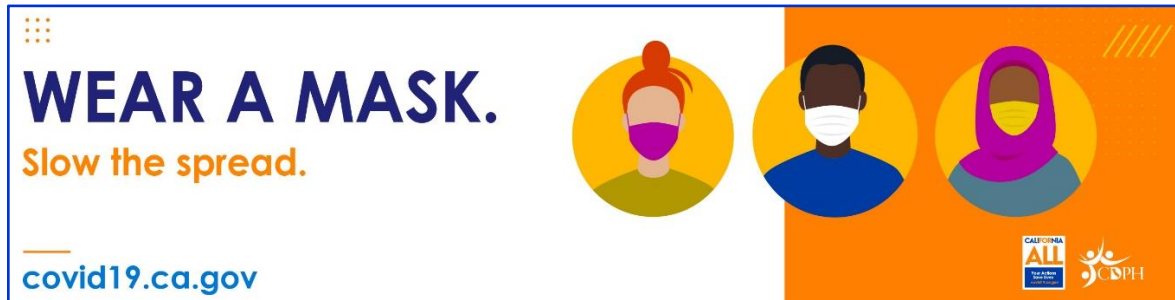


Friday Update

Friday, August 7, 2020

This update provides information primarily on COVID-19 issues related to Yuba Community College District, and shares information, resources and news from local, state and national media outlets.



Current Status by the Numbers

As of this morning, there are a total of 3,598 confirmed cases of coronavirus in the five counties served by the Yuba Community College District. That is an 18% increase over the previous week.

Current case totals are: Colusa – 361, a 19% increase; Lake – 212, a 17% increase; Sutter – 893, a 22% increase; Yolo – 1,660, a 12% increase with 747 cases in Woodland, a 2% increase; and Yuba – 572, a 29% increase. A total of 51,135 people have been tested, an increase of 8% over the previous week. Currently there are 36 patients hospitalized in our service area, 4 more than the previous week, and 58 fatalities, three more than last week. Local data comes from county coronavirus web pages.

Statewide there are a total of 529,980 confirmed cases, an increase of 11% over the previous week. A total of 8,500,463 tests have been completed, an increase of 13%. Total patients currently hospitalized are 6,069, a 12% decrease and the number of ICU patients is 1,828, a decrease of 9%.
