COVID-19 STATUS IN YCCD SERVICE AREA

As of March 21, 2021 there are a total of 33,405 confirmed cases of coronavirus in the five county region served by the Yuba Community College District. That is an increase of .9% over last Sunday. Total cases are shown in the chart below. Increases by county since last Sunday are: Colusa – .0%; Lake – .8%; Sutter – .1%; Yolo – 1.1%, with a 1.1% increase in Woodland; and Yuba – .8%. 32,783 of the confirmed cases (98.1% of the total cases count) have been classified as recovered. Currently there are 622 active cases in the service area. County data is from local county website dashboards. Statewide there are a total of 3,545,278 confirmed cases, an increase of 1.3% since last Sunday.

Currently there are 23 individuals hospitalized in our service area, which is seven less than last week. There are eight patients in ICU, which is three less than last week. There have been 390 fatalities, four more than last week.

Total patients hospitalized in the state is 2,690, a 22.6% decrease since last Sunday, and the first time below 3,000 since the second week of November. COVID VACCINE UPDATE

Statewide there have been a total of 14,520,575 vaccine doses administered. 4,635,570 individuals (11.6%) have been partially vaccinated, and 5,130,943 individuals (12.9% of state's population) have been fully vaccinated. A total of 168,434 vaccine shots have been administered in our five county region.

Vaccine administration varies county to county. All counties in our service area are vaccinating educational workers at this time. Please check with your local county website for the latest vaccine information.
