# VISION 2030: CALIFORNIA'S STATEWIDE STRATEGIC FRAMEWORK

## What is Vision 2030?

- CA Community Colleges strategic plan (July 2023)
- Built on Vision for Success (2017) + Governor's Roadmap (2021)
- Philosophy: Proactive outreach, locally-determined targets
- Led by Chancellor Sonya Christian

## Three Strategic Goals:

1. Equity in Access: Broader participation in higher education across all communities
2. Equity in Support: Academic, financial, and social supports through partnerships
3. Equity in Success: Academic and career success for all current and prospective students

Today's focus: Equity In Success - 5 outcomes tracked at the district and college level, disaggregated by demographics.

## Completion

Earned a degree, certificate  $\geq 16$  units, or transferred to a four-year institution

## ADT Awards

Associate Degree for Transfer (AA-T or AS-T) with guaranteed CSU admission

## Transfer to Four-Year

Transfer to any four-year institution — UC, CSU, private, or out-of-state

## Living Wage Attainment

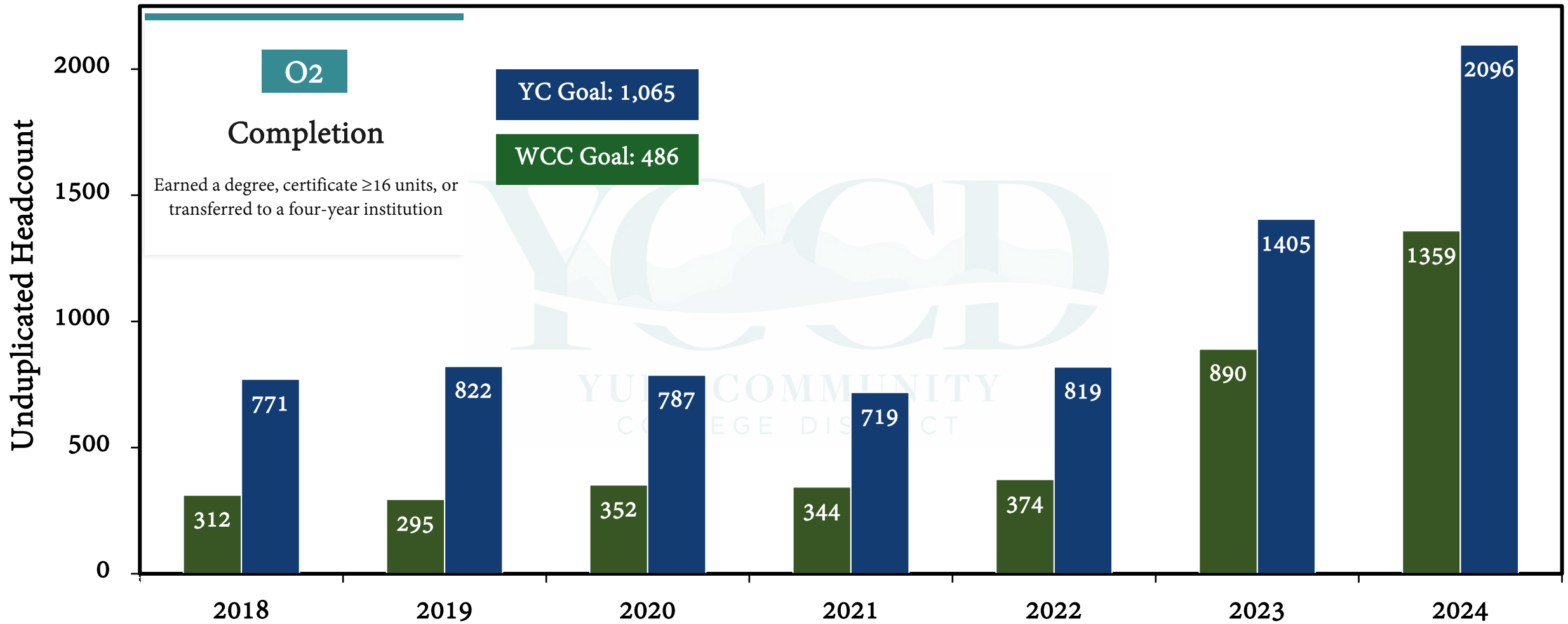
% of exiting students earning county-specific living wage post-exit

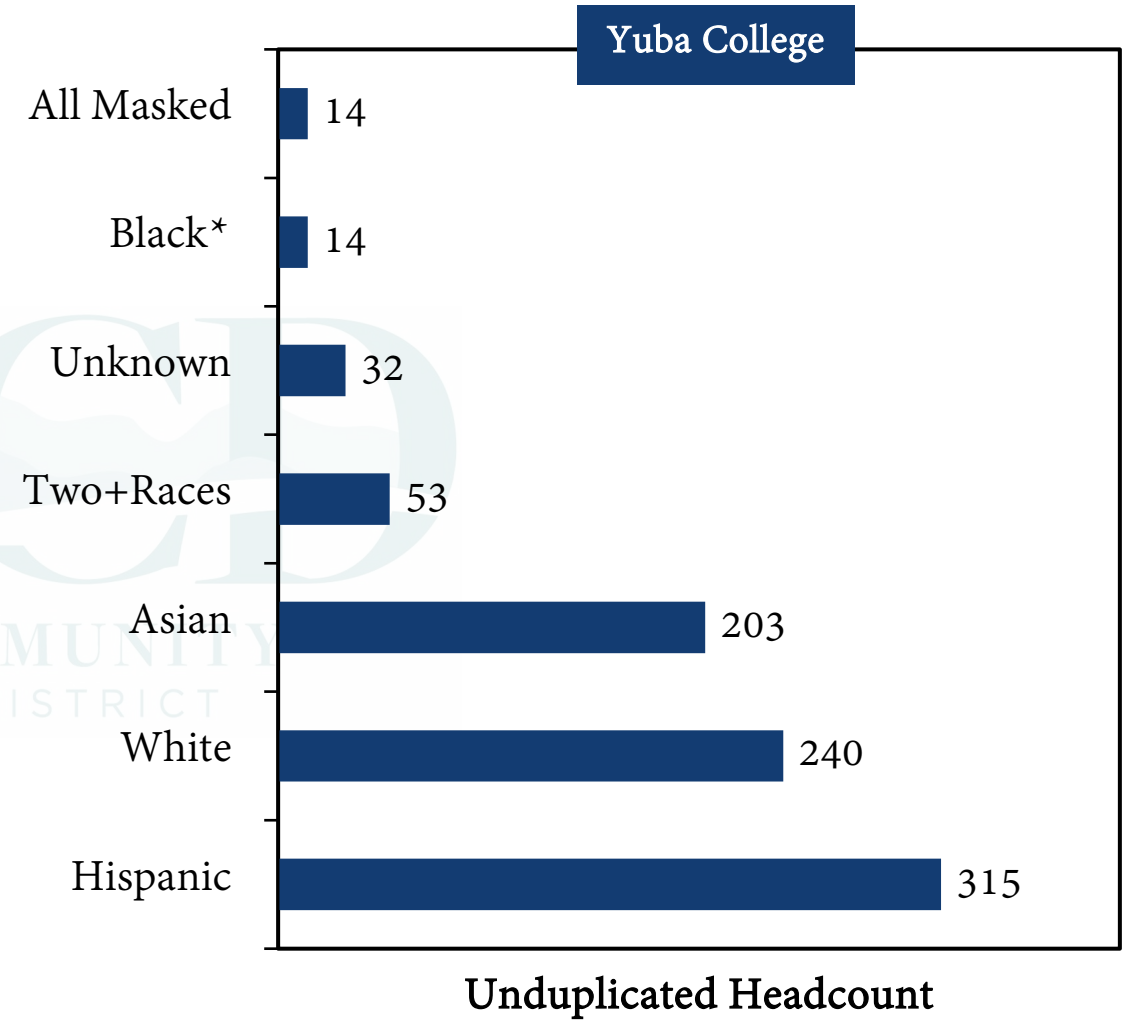
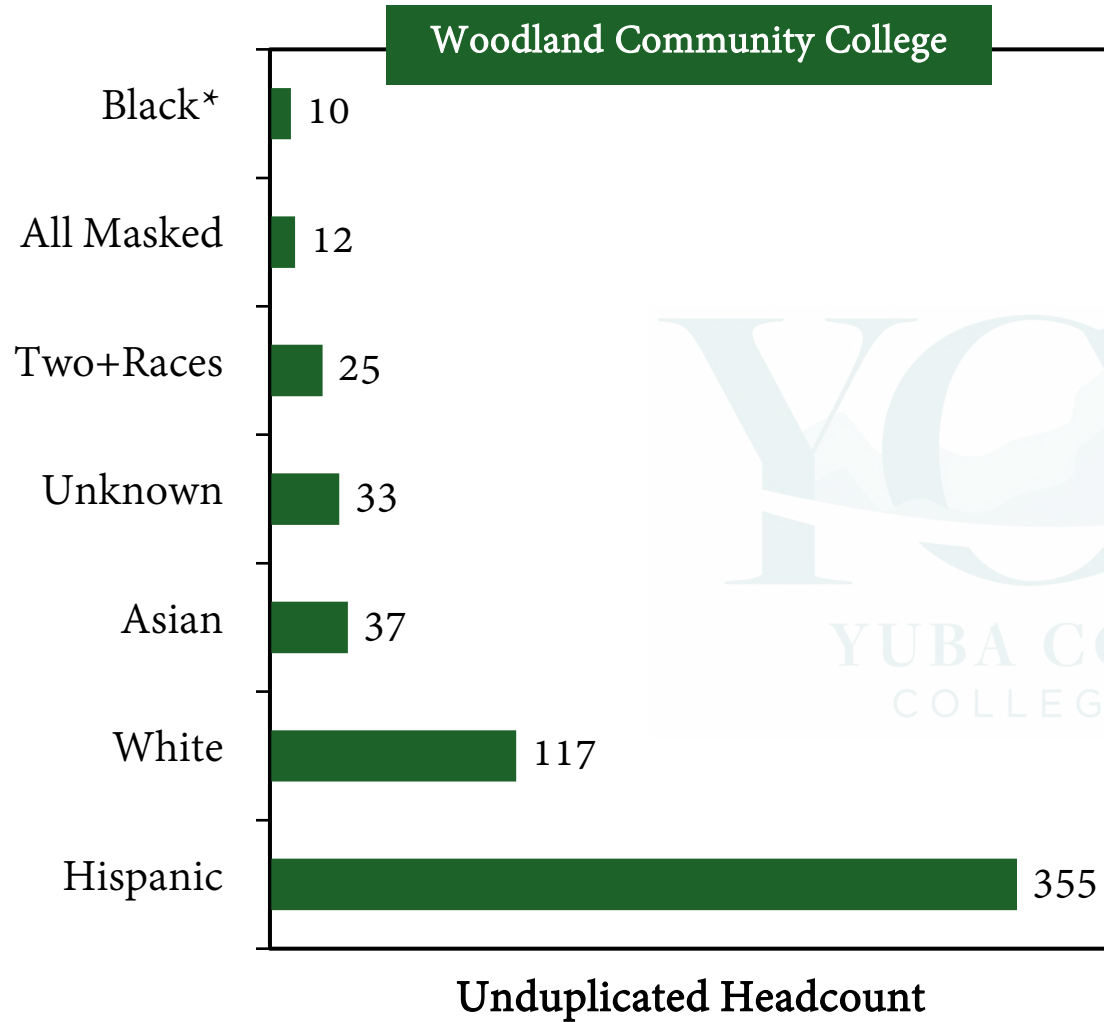
## Avg Units to ADT

Average units to ADT — fewer units = less time, less cost, more efficient

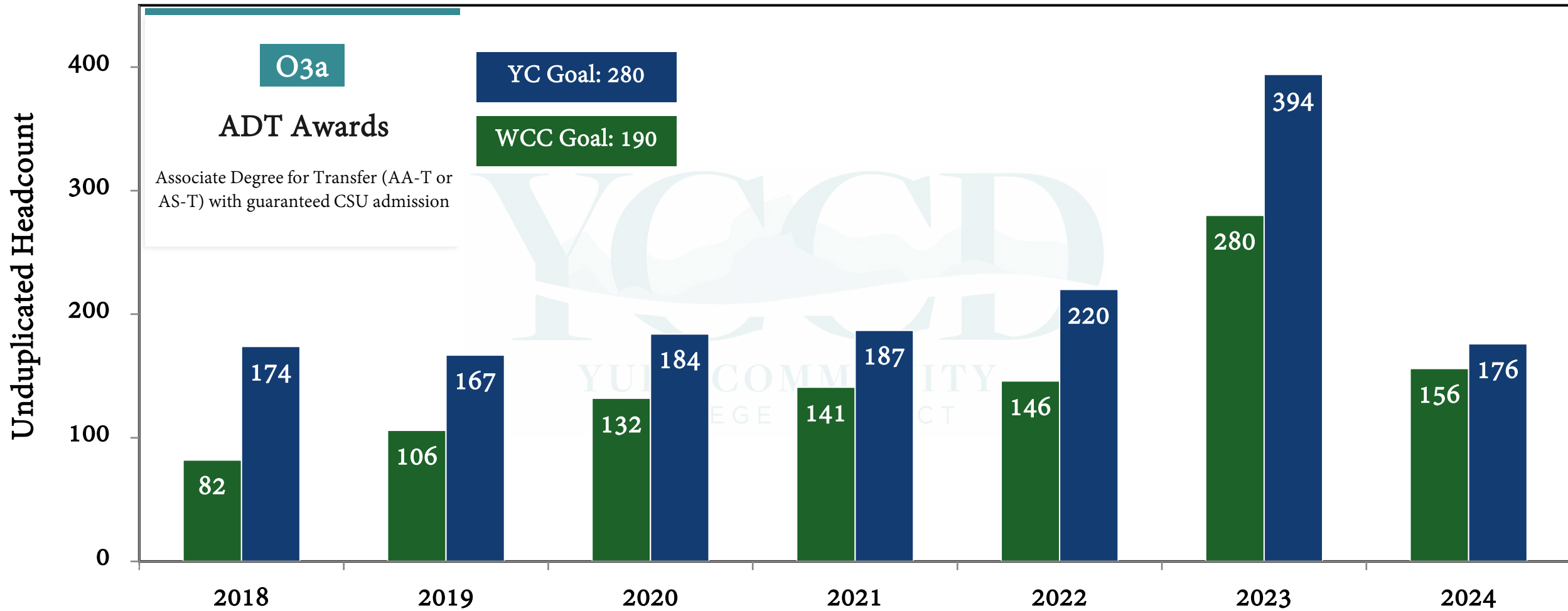
# COMPLETION IS SURGING — BOTH COLLEGES EXCEED GOAL



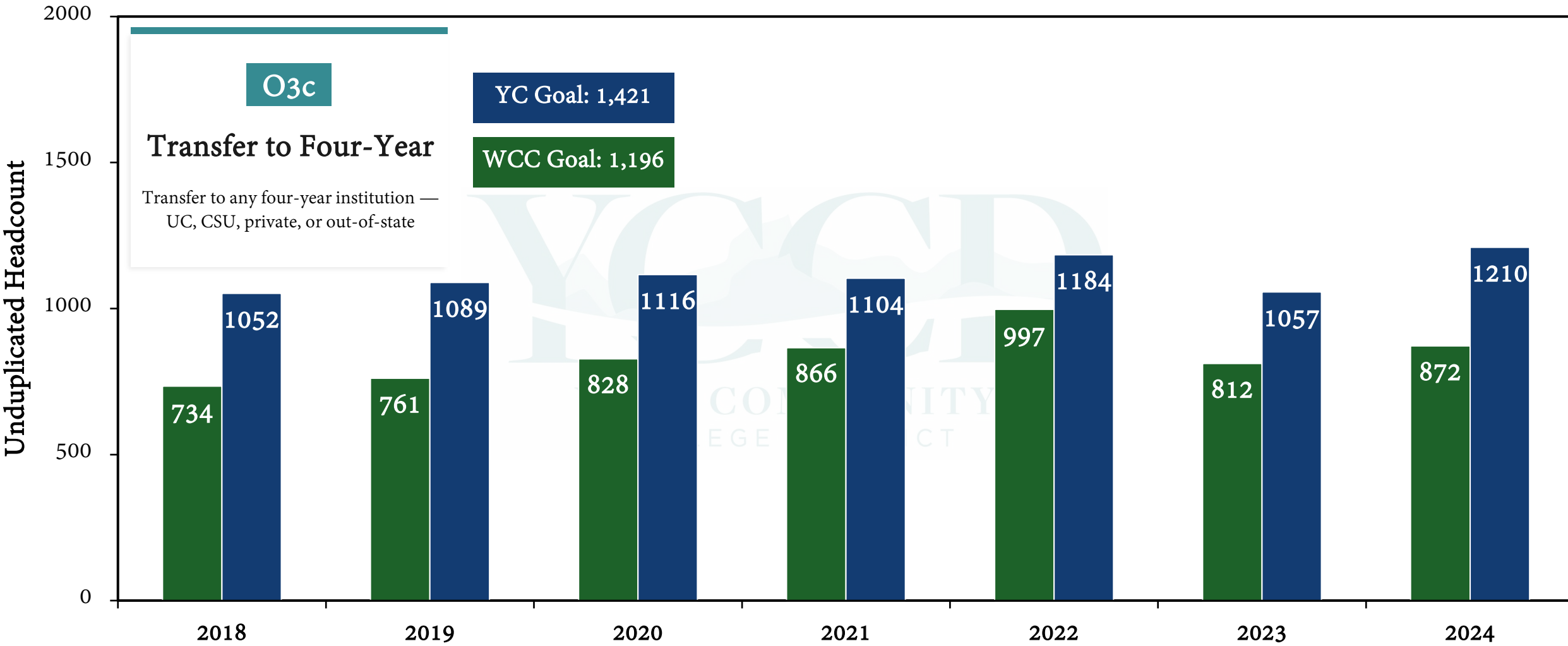
# DISAGGREGATING COMPLETION BY ETHNICITY

# TRANSFER – MOVING TOWARDS VISION 2030



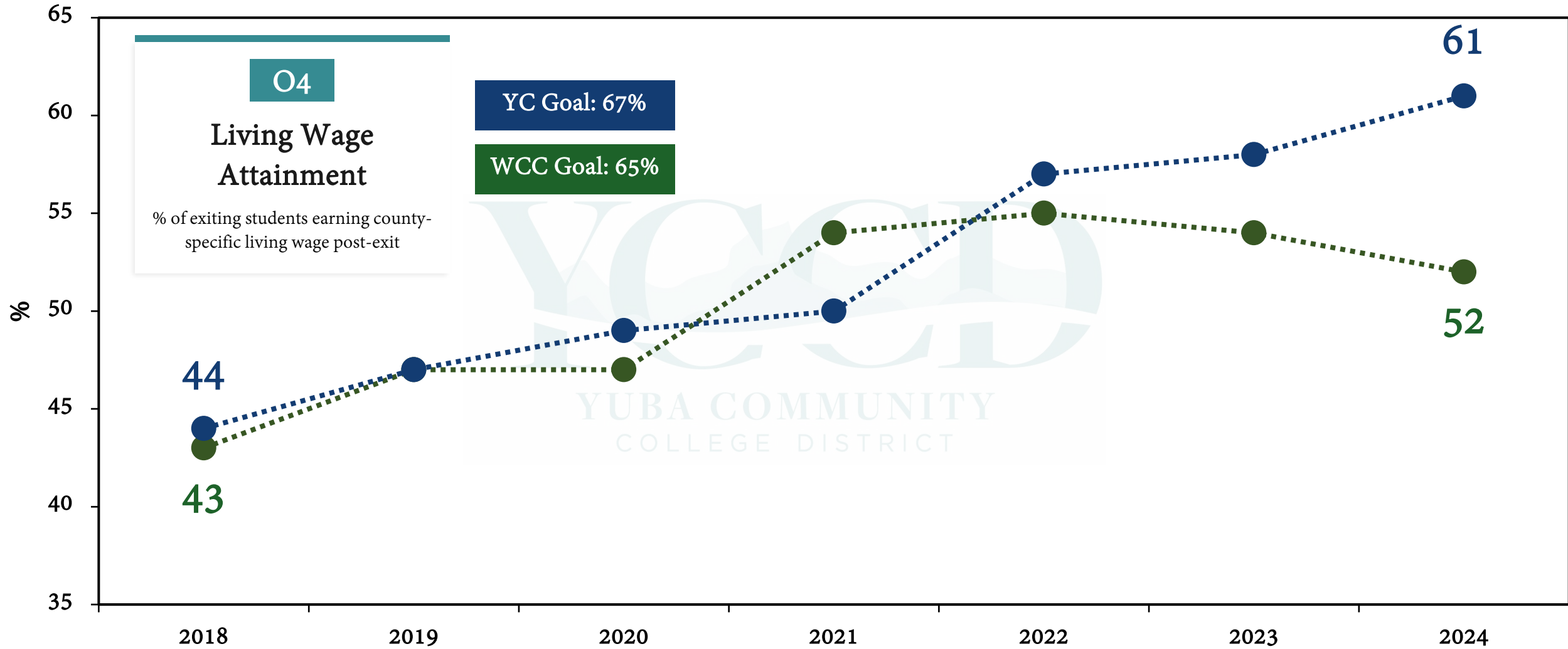
